About Puridify

Puridify is developing nanofibre based materials to increase the productivity of bioprocessing in areas such as biotherapeutic purification and industrial biotechnology. This is a unique opportunity to become part of a rapidly growing company and be integral to the shaping of a new technology for industrial bioprocessing.

Puridify is based at the Stevenage Bioscience Catalyst incubator which is a 20min train journey from central London and 40min from Cambridge.

Main Responsibilities

The post holder will be responsible for the management, design, and execution of feasibility studies with Puridify's collaborators who represent major players in the pharma/biopharma industry. This will involve reporting directly to Puridify executives with a high degree of autonomy. Working with a small technical team in the creation of internal data for technical application notes is expected. This role requires in depth experience of working in purification process development across multiple chromatographic technologies that will have been gained from >3 years of hands-on industrial experience. Importantly, the successful candidate will be able to demonstrate a commercial understanding of the industry combined with the organisational and inter-personal skills required to work with external partners.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Scope technical requirements for target data packages aligned with industry goals.
- Coordinate projects between Puridify and its collaborators including resources, budgeting, timelines, materials, and understand the legal frameworks of such work.
- Write and present project outcomes to collaborators and Puridify team.
